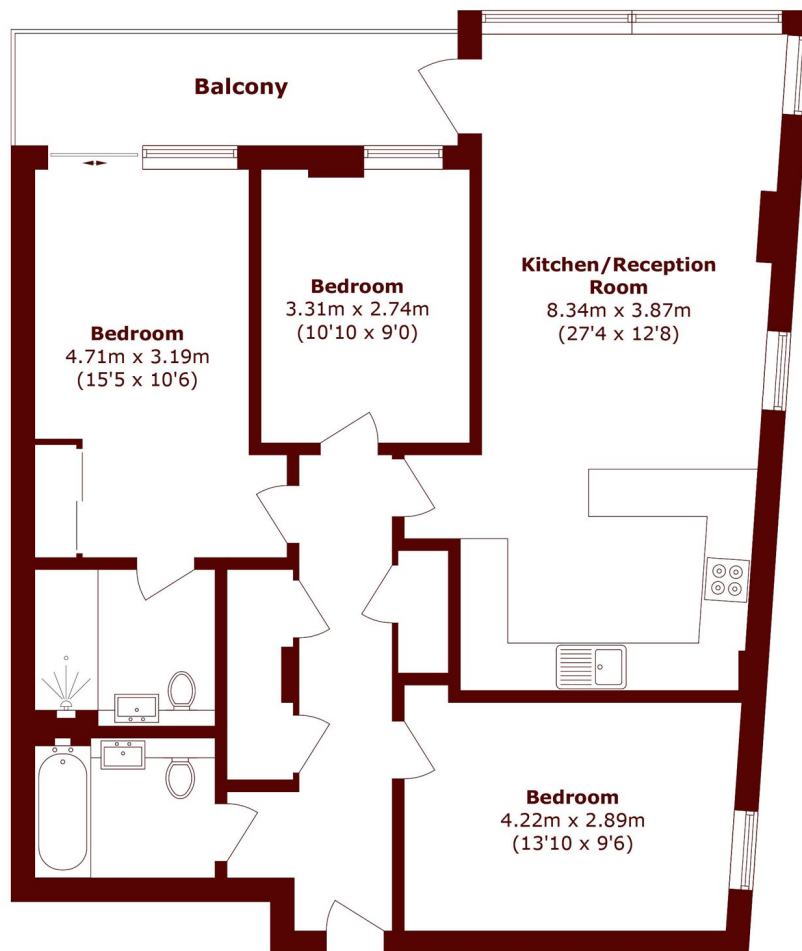
FURTHER DETAILS
